

## ***2010 SUNBURN CLASSIC 14U BASEBALL TOURNAMENT***

Dear Coaches, (Parents, Players)

Welcome to the 2010 Sunburn Classic 14u Baseball Tournament, sponsored by the Twin City Titans Senior Legion baseball team. The tournament will be held Memorial Day weekend, Saturday May 29th through Monday May 31st 2010.

We believe that the teams participating in the 2010 Sunburn Classic will consist of some of the finest 13 and 14 year old baseball players from around the Pacific Northwest.

Round Robin play will begin at 8:00am Saturday morning at either Hanford High School Varsity baseball field (on George Washington Way in North Richland) or the Richland High School Varsity baseball field (on Lee Blvd where Wellsian Way ends) and at 9:00am on the Columbia Basin Community College baseball field (on Argent Street and North 20<sup>th</sup> Ave. just off Highway 182) in Pasco. The last games on Monday are scheduled to begin no later than 4:00pm to allow those teams who are traveling several hours to return home at a reasonable hour.

Directions to the baseball fields are very simple. For Richland High School, take highway 182 (coming from either the east or the west), take George Washington Way (the main north/south street through Richland) which only goes north. Follow George Washington Way to Lee Blvd. Turn left (west) onto Lee Blvd, go through the circle and follow Lee until you see the baseball field. If you go up the hill on Lee Blvd, you have gone too far. For Hanford High School, take George Washington Way all the way thru Richland to the north end of Richland. You will see the field on the right side. For Columbia Basin College, take highway 182 (coming from either the east or the west), take North 20<sup>th</sup> Ave (towards the Pasco Airport), turn left onto Argent Street, turn left into the CBC Main Entrance. At the circle, go right and follow the road until you see the baseball field.

Awards will be presented to the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place teams immediately following the championship game.

We greatly appreciate your participation in our tournament and are looking forward to some exciting baseball. We want to encourage good sportsmanship from the coaches, players and fans. We are confident that the young boys we will see on the field are future high school and college players. They are the ones that will make this an exciting and enjoyable tournament. So sit back, relax, enjoy the sun, the community and of course, the games.
